Background Terms for faculty members on the faculty promotions committee currently are two years. (Terms for faculty members on the tenure committee are three years.) The quick turnover on this committee means that members have a short time in which to get up to speed on committee practices, and then after an initial year, they may become chair or co-chair of the committee. A three-year term would allow for development of deeper knowledge over time of committee practices as well as provide for ample training before stepping into the chair or co-chair role. Consistency across years, especially if terms are staggered, can also provide valuable knowledge and experience. A three-year term would also be a logical parallel to the term of service on the tenure committee.

Proposal

The Promotions Committee proposes changing the term of service for members of the committee to three years beginning with the election of new members, spring 2017.

The Promotions Committee and the President will review deliberations of the Committee before recommendations are finalized and forwarded.

The President will recommend promotions to the Board and may seek assistance in making such presentations from the Vice President for Instruction or from faculty members as seems appropriate.

Chair Election: Chair to be elected annually by the committee

^{**} The administrative appointment on Promotions Committee will either be an Instructional Dean or if that is not possible, another administrator who has three years minimum instructional experience.
