The pricing structure of the Bookstore is designed to make books, services, and supplies available to students at reasonable prices, while covering its cost of operations.

Textbooks:

Adoptions: An online Textbook Adoption Form~~s~~ must be completed by each instructor for each course they are teaching each term, approved by the Department Chair and submitted to the Bookstore by the established term deadline (Fall: ~~May 4~~ April 15; Winter: October ~~30~~15; Spring: January ~~30~~15; Summer: April ~~17~~1). Textbook ~~A~~adoptions submitted after the deadline may not arrive on time without additional expense to the Department and will not be included in consideration for Buy-Back. Assumptions about the current or continuing textbook inventory should not be made. Regardless of whether a textbook has been used in the past or is currently in inventory, an ~~A~~adoption form must be received to guarantee sufficient textbooks for a class. ~~An A~~adoption form must be received even if no textbook is required and so stating that fact. ~~Text~~Books not adopted will be returned to the publisher each term.
