CASTELLS



A castell is a human tower and is a 'tradition' in Barcelona. Historically this practice appeared near the begining of the 19th century in Tarragona near Barcelona. Colles are the teams of castellers who construct the castells. The construction of human towers has become a point of Catalan national pride and has a rich culture from the names of the different layers of the castell to the music played as they are constructed. 9 layers is a significant achievement and 10 layers have been reached recently. The creating of castells is recognized as a UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage. Castells are a part of nearly every festival in Barelona so I'm sure we will see them.

PLACES IN BARCELONA

Camp Nou:

Camp Nou is the stadium of FC Barcelona. It has a capacity of nearly 100,000 and is the largest stadium in Europe (4th largest in the world). The stadium is mostly used for football matches but is also a venue for large concerts (Bruce Springsteen) or public events (Mass by Pope John Paul II).
